

## 2019-20 Committee & Board Subcommittee Appointment Procedures

It is that time again to begin the process of appointing committee and task force members for the next year (2019-20). Recommendations are **due no later than May 15, 2019**.

Below is the procedure we will follow in recommending committee appointments:

Committee appointments are greatly sought after; each year we receive many more applicants than there are openings. Every attempt is made to fairly distribute committee appointments throughout the membership. When choosing committee members, IEA officers look for diversity of membership types, members' locations around the state and a variety of other factors to make sure committees reflect the full picture of our association. While we respect and appreciate past service immensely, **it is crucial for the organization to involve new members. Members who are leaving a committee should not expect an immediate appointment to another committee.** This is to make room for new involvement.

Current committee members who wish to stay on a committee will need to complete the recommendation form. **Current committee members should not assume they will remain on a committee.**

Expectations of each committee member working for IEA-NEA will be great, thus we ask that you keep this in mind as you submit names. Please consider both interest and expertise but, also, keep in mind the importance of involving new members. **Please check with those you want to recommend and confirm they are willing to serve on the committee. You may nominate yourself too.** Perhaps we can give some of our veteran activists a year or two of rest as we make an extra effort to involve newer members.

What follows is a list of all current committees. This is under review and may be modified for next year. Please use this list, but be aware it could be altered by the time appointments are approved by the IEA Board of Directors.
